

The RMTTS-C Program is being offered October 12 through October 15, 2015 at the Anschutz Medical Campus in Aurora, Colorado. The cost of the program is \$1,200 and includes the training, examination, and certification.

## What is a Certified TTS?

A Certified Tobacco Treatment Specialist has completed an intensive training program accredited by the Association for the Treatment of Tobacco Use and Dependence (ATTUD). This growing group of professionals have an advanced and specialized skillset that makes them a valuable addition to any interdisciplinary team. A TTS can work in many healthcare settings and may be eligible to bill for tobacco cessation services.

The fully accredited RMTTS-C Program provides a comprehensive and convenient process by which interdisciplinary healthcare providers and community and public health professionals can become TTScertified. This program offers the highest quality tobacco cessation training based on the latest evidence-based research and treatment strategies.

## The 4-day RMTTS-C Program:

- Focuses on providing the knowledge, clinical skills, and evidence-based treatment strategies to effectively treat tobacco dependence
- Consists of focused instruction, interactive and hands-on learning activities, group discussion, and role-play
- Includes an on-site, two-part exam with a multiple choice/short answer component and a case study component
- Offers a convenient process for participants to receive certification
