1. Applying entities must be organizations (not individuals).
 Health navigators must be currently employed by a healthcare organization, local public health agency, Regional Accountable Entity (RAE), etc.
3. Navigators must be prepared to complete the competency assessment on May 21 st at the <u>Center for Advancing Professional Excellence</u> (CAPE) or on another date (to be determined) depending on the demand generated through this scholarship opportunity.
Note: any additional sessions will be scheduled before June 29, 2019.
4. Health navigators eligible to take the competency assessment are those who successfully completed a recognized training program in October 2018 or after. If navigators don't qualify based on this requirement, they might be eligible for a waiver if they:
A. Completed a CDPHE-funded training program between June 2015 and June 2018B. Demonstrate approximately 4,000 hours of experience as a lay navigator
