

# RADIOLOGY AND PATHOLOGY REPORT EXAMPLES

Results of the lung cancer screening low dose CT will be provided to the ordering clinician in a radiology report that should be provided in a structured reporting format with Lung-RADs category, recommended management steps, and comparison to prior chest CT scans. If lung tissue is taken during a biopsy or surgery to determine if a lung nodule is cancerous or not, the results will be provided in a pathology report.

An article in [RadioGraphics](#) about lung cancer screening implementation contains an example of a radiology report (Figure 4) that contains elements of structured reporting specific for lung cancer screening. An overview of each element is also provided.
